SCHOLARSHIPS

- Each of our nine branches will award two (2) \$1,000 scholarships.
- Recipients will be selected by local branch managers and the Old West scholarship committee.
- The scholarship recipients must be enrolled in an accredited post-high school institution or vocational school.

SELECTION OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

The scholarship committee will consider:

- Community involvement.
- · Academic achievements.
- Motivation.
- Attitude.
- Financial need.
- Leadership.

APPLICATION PROCESS

NOTIFICATION

Applicants shall receive notification of the committee's decision *approximately* 30 days after the application deadline.

Instructions Exhibit B

Old West Federal Credit Union Scholarship Program

- 1. Complete the Scholarship Application.
- 2. Attach a separate statement, written or typed (font size 12), summarizing your need for this scholarship, your career aspirations, and your educational plans to meet your goals.
- 3. Include a photo. If you are a scholarship awardee, we would like to share your photo on our website and other media outlets. By providing a photo of yourself, you are giving OWFCU *implied permission* to use your photo image. If you are under the age of 18, a parent/legal guardian's signature is required. See *minor photo release form* in the packet.
- 4. Include two letters of recommendation from individuals who are not related to you. At least one of the letters must be from a school staff member or administrator who is familiar with you.
- 5. Include an official high school transcript from your first year of high school to present. This should be signed by the proper school official showing the courses taken and grades received.
- 6. Please include documentation relating to any achievements in leadership, academics, athletics, school activities, community service, and other activities.
- 8. The application, and all supporting documents must be delivered to an Old West Federal Credit Union branch near you on, or before, April 15, 2025, no later than 5:30 P.M.
